COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 323, L.D. 1090, Bill, "An Act To Allow a Stay of an Administrative License Suspension for Refusal To Submit to a Test"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 4-A in the last line (page 1, line 8 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "issued." the following: 'A stay does not apply during a delay caused or requested by the petitioner.'

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that a stay of license suspension does not apply when the delay of hearing is caused or requested by the petitioner.
