4 This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

5 This bill proposes to allow the caregiver of an individual entitled to a free fishing  
6 license because of a disability, when that disability limits that individual's ability to fish  
7 independently, to assist that individual's fishing without being required to obtain a fishing  
8 license.
