11	Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:	
12	'Resolve, To Require the Commissioner of Labor To Convene a Stakeholder Group	
13 14	To Determine the Most Appropriate Amount of Time an Employer May Employ an Employee without Being Subject to Unemployment Compensation Requirements'	
15	Amend the bill by striking out everything after the title and before the summary and	
16	inserting the following:	
17	'Sec. 1. Stakeholder group; report. Resolved: That the Commissioner of	
18	Labor or the commissioner's designee shall convene a stakeholder group to determine the	
19	most appropriate amount of time an employer may employ an employee without the	
20	employer's being subject to unemployment compensation requirements. The	
21 22	commissioner or the commissioner's designee shall invite the participation of	
22	representatives from the Maine Merchants Association, the Maine State Chamber of Commerce, the National Federation of Independent Businesses and the Maine Tourism	
23	Association. The commissioner or the commissioner's designee shall submit a report with	
25	the stakeholder group's recommendations to the Joint Standing Committee on Labor,	
26	Commerce, Research and Economic Development by January 15, 2012. The joint	
27	standing committee is authorized to introduce a bill related to the report to the Second	
28	Regular Session of the 125th Legislature.'	
29	SUMMARY	
30	This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, strikes and replaces	
31	the bill, makes the bill a resolve and directs the Commissioner of Labor to establish a	
32	stakeholder group to determine the most appropriate amount of time an employer may	
33	employ an employee without the employer's being subject to unemployment	
34	compensation requirements.
