13 14	Amend the bill in section 1 in §434 in subsection 2 by striking out all of paragraphs D and E (page 1, lines 17 to 19 in L.D.) and inserting the following:
15	D. A county in which the computer resource was located.

17 18 19	This amendment strikes from the bill proposed language that is unnecessary. The items listed in the stricken language are included by definition in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 17-A, section 434, subsection 2.
