17 18 19 20 21	This amendment changes the process of notification of abandoned, lost or stolen property in the possession of a state law enforcement agency to require the notification to be posted in a newspaper of general circulation in the county in which the property was taken into custody, instead of in a newspaper having statewide circulation as the bill proposes.
