An Act To Improve Oil Storage Facility Operator Training

1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §564, sub-§2-A, ¶L, as enacted by PL 2009, c. 319, §7, is amended to read:

L. Operators to complete a department training program that meets the minimum requirements specified by the United States Environmental Protection Agency under United States Code, Section 6991i (2007). <u>The training program must provide</u> certification for the successful completion of the program, which must be renewed every 3 years. <u>Training may be provided by a 3rd party if approved by the</u> department.

SUMMARY

11 Current rules of the Department of Environmental Protection require persons in 12 charge of the daily operations of oil storage facilities to undergo a department training 13 program in the monitoring, maintenance and operating procedures of those facilities. 14 This bill requires the training program to be completed every 3 years and allows the 15 department to approve training done by a 3rd party.
