COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “**A**” to S.P. 386, L.D. 1265, Bill, “An Act To Allow the Unclaimed Remains of a Veteran To Have Proper Burial”

Amend the bill in section 1 in §2900 in subsection 2 in the 3rd line (page 1, line 22 in L.D.) by striking out the following: “120 days” and inserting the following: ‘one year’

SUMMARY

This amendment increases the time period in the bill after which a funeral director may dispose of or relinquish possession of a veteran's cremated remains from 120 days to one year.
