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HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to S.P. 389, L.D. 1268, Bill, "An Act To Allow the
9 Repayment of Improperly Awarded Workers' Compensation Benefits"

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Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 in the 7th line from the end (page 1, line
11 18 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "injustice." the following: 'A request for
12 recovery of overpayment must be made by the employer or insurer within 2 years of the
13 final court decision or final determination that results in an overpayment having been
14 made.'

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SUMMARY

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This amendment requires that a request by an employer or insurer for recovery of
17 overpayment must be made within 2 years of the final court decision or final
18 determination that results in an overpayment having been made.
