Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
CONCEPT DRAFT
SUMMARY
This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.
This bill proposes to amend the Pine Tree Development Zone program to allow a business that meets all the requirements for classification as a qualified Pine Tree
Development Zone business but the requirement that employees' wages be at least equal to the labor market average weekly wage to be designated as a qualified Pine Tree Development Zone business and thus eligible for benefits under that program.
