1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. Waiver of penalties for nonconforming school administrative**
3 **units.** Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 20-A, chapter 103-A and
4 Public Law 2007, chapter 240, Part XXXX, as amended, the provisions of Title 20-A,
5 section 15696 do not apply to School Administrative District No. 32, serving the
6 municipalities of Ashland, Garfield Plantation, Masardis, Oxbow Plantation and Portage
7 Lake, and School Administrative District No. 33, serving the municipalities of
8 Frenchville and St. Agatha, to allow those school administrative districts more time to
9 organize under Title 20-A, chapter 103-A and Public Law 2007, chapter 240, Part
10 XXXX, as amended.

11 **SUMMARY**

12 This bill waives the penalties for nonconforming school administrative units for
13 School Administrative District No. 32 and School Administrative District No. 33 to allow
14 those school administrative districts more time to organize under the school
15 administrative unit consolidation laws.
