1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §3024, 4th \P, as amended by PL 2001, c. 222, §3, is further amended to read:
4 5 6 7 8 9	The Chief Medical Examiner may authorize any other expenses necessary to carry out the Chief Medical Examiner's duties. The Chief Medical Examiner shall reimburse a funeral establishment that transports a body to Augusta at the request of the Office of Chief Medical Examiner at the following rates: for up to and including the first 25 miles, \$120; for the next 25 miles, \$2 per mile traveled while actually transporting a body; and for miles in excess of 50, \$1.75 per mile traveled while actually transporting a body.

11 12 13	This bill increases the fee paid to a funeral establishment to transport a body to Augusta at the request of the Department of the Attorney General, Office of Chief Medical Examiner.
