#### 1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 3 MRSA §802, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 507, §1, is amended to read:

Legislative service after December 2, 1986. All For a member who has 5 years
or more of creditable service on December 1, 2012, all legislative service of a the
member after December 2, 1986, for which contributions are made, shall be allowed as is
creditable service. For a member who has less than 5 years of creditable service on
December 1, 2012, all legislative service of the member after December 2, 1986 to
December 1, 2012 for which contributions are made is creditable service.

### SUMMARY

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11 This bill terminates creditable service under the Legislative Retirement Program for 12 members who have less than 5 years of creditable service on December 1, 2012.
