

HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 960,
L.D. 1314, Bill, "An Act To Standardize the Definition of "Independent Contractor"

Amend the amendment in section 8 in subsection 13-A in paragraph A in
subparagraph 4 in the 2nd line (page 3, line 26 in amendment) by inserting after the
following: "employees," the following: "secures the payment to those employees of
compensation provided for by this Act and"

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that an independent contractor must provide workers'
compensation insurance for employees of that independent contractor.
