
HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 960,
L.D. 1314, Bill, "An Act To Standardize the Definition of "Independent Contractor"

Amend the amendment in section 9 by striking out all of paragraph B (page 4, line 9
in amendment) and inserting the following:

'B. "Construction subcontractor" means an independent contractor if the construction
subcontractor meets the definition of independent contractor in section 102,
subsection 13-A.'

SUMMARY

This amendment specifies that a construction subcontractor is considered an
independent contractor only if that person meets the definition of independent contractor.
