1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 34-A MRSA §11221, sub-§9-A is enacted to read:
3 4 5 6	9-A. Registry information. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, except to the extent required to permit access to information pursuant to subsection 9, information administered, maintained or contributed to by the bureau in connection with the registry may not be publicly accessed or disseminated.
7	SUMMARY
8	This bill provides that, except to the extent required to permit access to information
9	identified in current law as publicly accessible, information administered, maintained or
10	contributed to by the Department of Public Safety, Bureau of State Police, State Bureau
11	of Identification in connection with the sex offender registry may not be publicly
12	accessed or disseminated.
