
SENATE AMENDMENT “ E ” to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “A” to H.P. 979,
L.D. 1333, Bill, “An Act To Modify Rating Practices for Individual and Small Group
Health Plans and To Encourage Value-based Purchasing of Health Care Services”

Amend the amendment in Part C in section 3 in §405-A in subsection 1 in the last
line (page 17, line 12 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "Massachusetts,"
the following: 'Vermont.'

Amend the amendment in Part C in section 4 in §405-B in the first indented
paragraph in the 4th line (page 18, line 39 in amendment) by inserting after the following:
"Massachusetts," the following: 'Vermont.'

SUMMARY

This amendment permits insurers and health maintenance organizations authorized to
transact individual health insurance in Vermont to offer their individual health plans for
sale in this State if certain requirements of Maine law are met. It also permits domestic
insurers and licensed health maintenance organizations to offer individual health plans of
a parent or corporate affiliate licensed to transact individual health insurance in Vermont
if similar requirements are met.
