This Part requires the State Budget Officer to calculate the amount of savings that applies against each Highway Fund account for all departments and agencies from savings associated with health insurance changes and to transfer the amounts by financial order upon the approval of the Governor.

PART Q

This Part authorizes the State Budget Officer to calculate the amount of savings that applies to each executive branch department and agency from the elimination of vacant positions and transfer the savings and related headcount by financial order upon the approval of the Governor.

PART R

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This Part includes adjustments to fiscal year 2010-11 allocations.
