2 3	Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §1208, sub-§1, ¶ C, as reallocated by PL 2009, c. 510, §7, is amended to read:
4	C. The If the licensee's establishment has a seating capacity of 40 or more persons,
5	the licensee's establishment includes at least 2 restrooms available for use by patrons.
6	If the licensee's establishment has a seating capacity of fewer than 40 persons, the
7	licensee's establishment includes at least one restroom available for use by patrons;
8	SUMMARY
9	This bill allows a restaurant with a seating capacity of fewer than 40 persons and only
10	one restroom to be issued a dual liquor license.
