4	This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.
5 6 7 8	This bill proposes to require that a routine technical agency rule that would cost the State \$1,000,000 must be considered by the Legislature before final adoption by an agency in the same manner as a major substantive rule pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 8072.
