11 Amend the amendment by striking out everything after the title and before the 12 summary and inserting the following:

13 'Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the14 summary and inserting the following:

15 'Sec. 1. 10 MRSA §9724, sub-§4-A is enacted to read:

16 <u>4-A. Exemption; municipal option.</u> A municipality may exempt from the
 17 requirement of the Maine Uniform Building and Energy Code any remodeling or
 18 additions to existing single-family residential buildings, if the original building was built
 19 prior to December 1, 2010.''

#### **SUMMARY**

This amendment strikes Committee Amendment "A" and the bill and replaces them with language that gives municipalities the option to exempt from the Maine Uniform Building and Energy Code any residential remodeling or additions on single-family residential buildings constrainted prior to December 1, 2010.
