SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1044, L.D. 1418, Bill, "An Act To Allow Table Games at a Facility Licensed To Operate Slot Machines on January 1, 2011"

Amend the amendment in section 10 in subsection 2-C in paragraph A in the first line (page 6, line 3 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Nine" and inserting the following: 'Seven'

Amend the amendment in section 10 in subsection 2-C in paragraph C in the last line (page 6, line 10 in amendment) by striking out the following: "and"

Amend the amendment in section 10 in subsection 2-C in paragraph D in the last line (page 6, line 15 in amendment) by striking out the following: "2013." and inserting the following: '2013; and'

Amend the amendment in section 10 in subsection 2-C by inserting after paragraph D the following:

'E. Two percent of net table game income must be forwarded directly to a federally recognized Indian tribe in the State licensed to conduct high-stakes beano on January 1, 2010.'

SUMMARY

This amendment provides that 2% of net table game income must be forwarded directly to a federally recognized Indian tribe in the State licensed to conduct high-stakes beano on January 1, 2010. It reduces the net table game income that must be deposited to the General Fund for administrative expenses of the Department of Public Safety, Gambling Control Board from 9% to 7%.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment proposes to reduce the amount of net table game income from the Bangor facility distributed to the General Fund from 9% to 7% and distribute 2% to a federally recognized Indian tribe. While the total tax remains at 16% of net table game income, the estimated annual net effect would be a reduction of \$106,240 in the General Fund revenue shown on the committee amendment and a payment of the same amount to the Indian tribe. The payment from the Bangor facility is contingent upon municipal approval of table games.
