1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 17-A MRSA §501-A, sub-§1, ¶ A , as enacted by PL 2007, c. 144, §3, is amended to read:
4 5	A. In a public place, the person intentionally or recklessly causes annoyance to others by intentionally:
6	(1) Making Makes loud and unreasonable noises;
7 8	(2) Activating <u>Activates</u> a device, or exposing exposes a substance, that releases noxious and offensive odors; or
9	(3) Engaging Engages in fighting, without being licensed or privileged to do so;
10	SUMMARY
11 12	This bill amends the law prohibiting disorderly conduct to remove the stipulation that the prohibited conduct recklessly causes annoyance to others.
