1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 25 MRSA §2806-A** is enacted to read:

3 **§2806-A. Suspension, revocation of retired law enforcement officers' retirement**
4 **credentials**

5 **1. Suspension, revocation of credentials.** A law enforcement agency may suspend
6 or revoke at any time any credential issued by the agency to an officer who has retired
7 from the agency if the retired officer engages in conduct or is convicted of a crime that
8 would have resulted in the revocation or suspension of the retired officer's law
9 enforcement certification if the officer were not retired.

10 **SUMMARY**

11 The bill permits a law enforcement agency to suspend or revoke any credential of an
12 officer who has retired from that agency if the officer engages in conduct or is convicted
13 of a crime that would have resulted in decertification of the officer if the officer was not
14 retired.
