
HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1093, L.D. 1486, Bill, "An Act To Amend the Laws Concerning the Child Care Advisory Council and the Maine Children's Growth Council"

Amend the bill in section 9 in subsection 2 by striking out all of paragraph Z (page 4, lines 3 to 5 in L.D.) and inserting the following:

'Z. One person representing home-based child care providers, appointed by the Governor.'

SUMMARY

This amendment changes the proposed new representative of unionized family child care providers on the Child Care Advisory Council to a representative of home-based child care providers, appointed by the Governor.
