SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the minority report of the committee, clarifies that the posting of information on the website of the Department of Administrative and Financial Services relates to contracts for purchases and not to contracts in a budget. It also moves the provision from the chapter on general provisions of finance to the chapter on purchases. It removes the language relating to posting information on the estimated cost of providing the products or services and the estimated number of employees required to fulfill the contract.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

The bill includes a General Fund appropriation to the Department of Administrative and Financial Services, Bureau of Purchases to implement the posting of state contract information on a publicly accessible web page. The estimated costs of \$171,500 in fiscal year 2011-12 and \$108,000 in fiscal year 2012-13 include funding for one Management Analyst I position, related general operating expenses and information technology costs. The first year includes \$70,000 for one-time information technology development costs.
