17 18	Amend the amendment in section 1 in §2188 by striking out all of subsection 2 and inserting the following:
19 20 21	'2. Permitted insurance producer or consultant activities. Only a person licensed as an insurance producer in this State in accordance with chapter 16, or, with respect to paragraph B, a person licensed as a consultant in accordance with chapter 16, may:
22	A. Sell, solicit or negotiate health insurance;
23 24 25	B. Make recommendations to purchasers, enrollees or employers or prospective purchasers or enrollees concerning the substantive benefits, terms or conditions of health plans; or

8	SUMMARY
9	This amendment incorporates the substantive provisions of House Amendment "A"
10	except that the amendment removes references to fingerprinting.
11	The amendment also clarifies the definition of "navigator" to include individuals
12	performing the duties of a navigator on behalf of an organization or business entity. The
13	amendment makes other technical and clarifying changes to Committee Amendment "A"
14	to be consistent with existing state law and rule and federal law and regulations.
