HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1126,
L.D. 1534, Bill, "An Act To Reform the Land Use and Planning Authority in the
Unorganized Territories"


Amend the amendment in section 2 by striking out all of subsections 3 and 4 and
inserting the following:

'3. Two county commissioners from the counties with the largest acreage in the
unorganized territory, one appointed by the Speaker of the House and one appointed by
the Governor;'

Amend the amendment in section 2 by renumbering the subsections to read
consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the 2 county commissioner members on the Commission
on Reform of the Governance of Land Use Planning in the Unorganized Territory with 2
county commissioners from the counties with the largest acreage in the unorganized
territory.
