16 17	'Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do no become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and	
18 19	Whereas, this legislation makes adjustments to the management and operations o the Maine Turnpike Authority; and	
20 21	Whereas, it is necessary that these changes be implemented as soon as possible t allow the Maine Turnpike Authority to correct prior deficiencies; and

2	terms expire on March 31st, serves until one year prior to the end of that member's

5	until the end of the 6-year term specified in subsections 1 and 2 or until the position
6	becomes vacant due to resignation, death, incapacity or removal of that member
7	whichever comes first.
8	As each position becomes vacant, the Governor shall appoint or reappoint a member
9	to a new term of 6 years or less in such fashion as to complete a rotation that will, as soon
10	as possible, yield terms that are staggered to comply with Title 23, section 1964-A
11	subsections 1 and 2.'
12	Amend the bill by adding after section 18 the following:
13	Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this
14	legislation takes effect when approved.'
15	SUMMARY
16	This amendment adds an emergency preamble and emergency clause to the bill and
17	amends the transition section for members of the board of directors of the Maine
18	Turnpike Authority to specify that the 6-year term limit, as changed by Committee
19	Amendment "A," applies to the current members of the board.
