HOUSE AMENDMENT "G" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 496,
L.D. 1553, Bill, "An Act To Create a Public Charter School Program in Maine"

Amend the amendment in section 5 in §2405 in subsection 8 by inserting after
paragraph D the following:

'E. A public charter school authorized by the commission must receive approval
from the legislative body of the school administrative unit in which the public charter
school will be located before that public charter school may operate.'

SUMMARY

This amendment requires a public charter school authorized by the State Charter
School Commission to receive approval from the legislative body of the school
administrative unit in which the public charter school will be located before that public
charter school may operate.
