Amend the amendment in section 5 in §2405 in subsection 8 by inserting after
11 paragraph D the following:

'E. A public charter school authorized by the commission must receive approval
13 from the legislative body of the school administrative unit in which the public charter
14 school will be located before that public charter school may operate.'

This amendment requires a public charter school authorized by the State Charter
