1 Sec. 1. Definitions. Resolved: That, as used in this resolve, unless the context 2 otherwise indicates, the following terms have the following meanings. 3 "Commissioner" means the Commissioner of Administrative and Financial 1. 4 Services. 5 2. "State property" means the real estate described in section 3 with the buildings and improvements, together with all appurtenant rights and easements, and all personal 6 property located on that property, including vehicles, machinery, equipment and supplies; 7 8 and be it further 9 Sec. 2. Authority to convey property. Resolved: That the State, by and 10 through the commissioner, may: 1. Convey the interests of the State in the state property to Regional School Unit 13; 11 12 2. Negotiate, draft, execute and deliver any documents necessary to settle any 13 boundary line discrepancies; 3. Exercise, pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 23, chapter 3, the power of 14 eminent domain to quiet for all time any possible challenges to ownership of the state 15 16 property; 17 4. Negotiate, draft, execute and deliver any easements or other rights that, in the commissioner's discretion, may contribute to the value of a proposed conveyance of the 18 19 State's interests: and 20 5. Release any interests in the state property that, in the commissioner's discretion, 21 do not contribute to the value of the remaining state property; and be it further 22 Sec. 3. Property interests that may be conveyed. Resolved: That the state 23 property authorized to be conveyed is the following: 24 1. A parcel of land described in a deed dated June 14, 1954 from Amos Makinen of 25 South Thomaston to the Maine School Building Authority, recorded in Book 336, Page 135, Knox County Registry of Deeds; and be it further 26 27 Sec. 4. Property to be sold "as is." Resolved: That the commissioner may 28 convey the state property without consideration upon terms the commissioner considers 29 appropriate; however, the state property must be conveyed "as is," with no 30 representations or warranties. 31 Title must be transferred by quitclaim deed without covenant and executed by the 32 commissioner: and be it further 33 **Sec. 5. Exemptions. Resolved:** That any conveyance pursuant to this resolve is 34 exempt from any statutory or regulatory requirement that the property first be offered to the Maine State Housing Authority or another state or local agency; and be it further 35

1	Sec. 6. Repeal. Resolved:	That this resolve is repealed 5 years from its effective
2	date.	

3 SUMMARY 4 This resolve authorizes the State to transfer ownership of the Guilford Butler School

5 in South Thomaston to Regional School Unit 13.
