COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1155, L.D. 1573, Bill, "An Act To Allow Retired Dentists To Obtain a License To Practice in Nonprofit Clinics"

Amend the bill in section 1 in the 2nd to last line (page 1, line 6 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "clinic" the following: 'without any remuneration for work performed at the clinic. The applicant must furnish proof satisfactory to the board that the applicant has been licensed to practice dentistry in this State and is in good standing with the board or, if the applicant was licensed to practice dentistry in another state or a Canadian province, that the applicant's professional education is no less than is required in this State and the applicant is in good standing and not subject to disciplinary action in the state or Canadian province in which the license was granted'

Amend the bill by adding after section 1 the following:

**Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and allocations are made.

13 **SUMMARY**

14 This amendment provides that a retired dentist who receives a limited license to  
 15 practice at a nonprofit dental clinic may not receive any remuneration for work performed  
 16 at the clinic. The amendment requires the applicant to furnish proof satisfactory to the  
 17 board that the applicant has been licensed to practice dentistry in this State and is in good  
 18 standing with the board. It also requires that an applicant licensed to practice dentistry in  
 19 another state or a Canadian province have professional education that is not less than  
 20 required in this State and that the applicant must be in good standing and not subject to  
 21 disciplinary action in the state or Canadian province in which the license was granted.  
 22 The amendment also adds an appropriations and allocations section.

#### Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill includes a one-time Other Special Revenue Funds allocation of \$2,500 in fiscal year 2011-12 to the Board of Dental Examiners, affiliated with the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation, for the costs associated with rulemaking. Additionally, this bill includes a one-time Other Special Revenue Funds allocation of \$2,500 in fiscal year 2011-12 to the Administrative Services Division within the department to update its licensing system. Both the board and the Administrative Services Division have sufficient funds to cover the one-time costs of this legislation.

This legislation will increase dedicated revenue to the Board of Dental Examiners from licensing fees. The amount can not be determined at this time.
