#### 1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §1084, as amended by PL 2003, c. 669, §4, is further amended
by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

4 <u>The board may issue a limited biennial license to a dentist who has retired from the</u> 5 <u>regular practice of dentistry for the purposes of permitting the dentist to practice solely in</u> 6 <u>a nonprofit dental clinic. The fee for a limited biennial license and renewal of a limited</u> 7 <u>biennial license is \$200.</u>

8 SUMMARY
9 This bill permits the Board of Dental Examiners to issue a limited license to a dentist
10 who has retired from the regular practice of dentistry for the purposes of permitting the
11 dentist to practice in a nonprofit dental clinic.
