7 This amendment directs the Secretary of State to issue the World Acadian Congress 8 commemorative plate established in the resolve at no cost to the Secretary of State. The 9 amendment also provides that the commemorative plate must bear the date of its 10 expiration, which is December 31, 2015. The amendment specifies that the plate may be 11 displayed in place of the front registration plate by covering, but not removing, the front registration plate. The amendment also directs the Secretary of State to develop a plan 12 13 for the sale and distribution of the World Acadian Congress commemorative plates. Fiscal Detail and Notes

This legislation establishes a special commemorative registration plate to celebrate the 2014 World Acadian Congress. The bill includes a Highway Fund allocation of \$6,963 beginning in fiscal year 2012-13 and ending in fiscal year 2015-16 for the cost of materials to manufacture the plates. Highway Fund revenues will increase by \$9,000 and Other Special Revenue Funds revenue will increase by \$16,000 beginning in fiscal year 2012-13 and ending in fiscal year 2015-16. This estimate assumes manufacture and sale of 1,000 plates each year. The Other Special Revenue Funds revenue Funds revenue Funds revenue will be forwarded by the State to the Maine Acadian Heritage Council.
