14 15 16	Amend the bill in section 3 in subsection 12 in the 2nd line from the end (page 2, line 17 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "from a vendor or subvendor" and inserting the following: 'of an expenditure made for the campaign'
17	Amend the bill by striking out all of section 4.
18 19	Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
20	SUMMARY
21 22 23 24 25	This amendment changes the title of the bill and clarifies language regarding reporting refunds of campaign expenditures. The amendment also strikes the section of the bill that requires vendors who are paid using Maine Clean Election Act funds to provide the candidate with an accounting of all payments to subvendors related to campaign advertising.
