11 12	Amend the bill in section 1 in §2174-B in subsection 1 by striking out all of paragraph B (page 1, lines 10 to 15 in L.D.) and inserting the following:
13	'B. "Emergency responder" means:
14 15 16	(1) A municipal firefighter, as defined in Title 30-A, section 3151, subsection 2; or a volunteer firefighter, as defined in Title 30-A, section 3151, subsection 4, who is operating a municipal vehicle; or
17 18 19 20 21	(2) An operator of a vehicle under Title 29-A, section 2054 that is licensed or authorized pursuant to Title 32, chapter 2-B as an ambulance or emergency medical services vehicle, when that operator is acting with the approval of an ambulance service or nontransporting service licensed pursuant to Title 32, chapter 2-B.'
22	SUMMARY
23 24 25 26	This amendment changes the definition of "emergency responder" to clarify that the protection extended in the bill applies only to motor vehicle accidents involving the use of a municipal vehicle or an emergency medical services vehicle licensed in accordance with state law and does not include accidents involving a personal vehicle of an

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emergency responder.
