| 1 2 | Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and |

| 3 4 | Whereas, planning and construction of a bridge in the Town of Turner are necessary and timely and costs must be contained for this bridge; and |
| 5 6 | Whereas, the planning and construction of a bridge in the Town of Turner might be initiated before the 90-day period expires; and |
| 7 8 9 10 | Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it |
| 11 12 13 | Sec. 1. Spending limit. Resolved: That the Department of Transportation may not exceed the amount of \$350,000 to build a bridge on the Ricker Hill Road over Martin Stream in the Town of Turner. |
| 14 15 | Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this legislation takes effect when approved. |

| 17 18 19 | This resolve prohibits the Department of Transportation from exceeding the amount of \$350,000 to build a bridge on the Ricker Hill Road over Martin Stream in the Town of Turner. |
