HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 570, L.D. 1671, Bill, "An Act To Provide Funding to the Department of Transportation for a Feasibility Study of an East-west Highway"

Amend the amendment in section 2 in the last line (page 1, line 24 in amendment) by striking out the following: "2013." and inserting the following: '2013; and be it further'

Amend the amendment by inserting at the end before the summary the following:

'Sec. 3. Reimbursement for cost of analysis. Resolved: That, if a contract is awarded for the construction of an east-west highway, the contract must require the contractor to reimburse the Department of Transportation for the cost of the analysis under section 1.'

This amendment provides that if a contract is awarded to construct an east-west highway, the contractor must reimburse the Department of Transportation for the cost of the feasibility study. It is assumed that if a contract is awarded, reimbursement would occur in a future biennium, increasing revenues by an estimated \$300,000 at that time.
