COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1247, L.D. 1695, Bill, "An Act To Provide Additional In-store Space for Maine's Businesses by Removing License and Permit Posting Requirements"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §1552-A in subsection 1 in the 2nd and 3rd lines (page 1, lines 6 and 7 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "or the owner's primary place of business"

Amend the bill in section 2 in the first paragraph in the 4th and 5th lines (page 1, lines 20 and 21 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "or at the person's, firm's, corporation's or copartnership's primary place of business"

Amend the bill in section 3 in §604 in the first paragraph in the 2nd and 3rd lines (page 1, lines 27 and 28 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "or at the licensees' primary places of business"

Amend the bill in section 4 in §3703 in the first paragraph in the 4th and 5th lines (page 1, lines 34 and 35 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "or at the licensee's or permittee's primary place of business"

Amend the bill in section 5 in subsection 2 in the blocked paragraph in the 3rd line (page 2, line 17 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "or at the retailer's primary place of business"

**SUMMARY**

This amendment removes provisions in the bill that allow licenses and permits to be made available at the licensee's or permittee's primary place of business, but retains the requirement that the license or permit be made available on the premises for inspection.
