An Act To Modify the Alternative Organizational Structure Budget Approval Process

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1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §1461-B, sub-§3, ¶C, as enacted by PL 2009, c. 580, §5, is
amended to read:

4 C. The budget procedures of member entities of an alternative organizational 5 structure must conform to the format and referendum procedures set forth in sections 6 1485 and 1486 for regional school units. The budget of the alternative organizational structure must be approved at a meeting of the voters of all of the member entities 7 8 conducted in accordance with the procedures applicable to a regional school unit 9 budget meeting except as provided in paragraph D. The budget of an alternative 10 organizational structure is not subject to a separate budget validation referendum as 11 described in section 1486.

12 Sec. 2. 20-A MRSA §1461-B, sub-§3, ¶D is enacted to read:

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13 D. The governing body of an alternative organizational structure, by majority vote, 14 may authorize a change in the alternative organizational structure budget approval procedures in paragraph C to require a budget approval by the governing body of the 15 alternative organizational structure instead of a meeting of the voters of all of the 16 member entities of the alternative organizational structure. The change in procedure 17 18 must be authorized by a majority of the total number of voters of all of the member 19 entities in the alternative organizational structure at the next statewide election. The article to be voted upon must be in substantially the following form: 20

21 <u>"Article: Do you favor changing the (name of alternative organizational</u>
22 <u>structure) budget approval procedure from a meeting of the voters to a vote by</u>
23 <u>the governing body of the alternative organizational structure?</u>

If approved by the voters, the budget approval procedure changes to a majority vote
of the governing body of the alternative organizational structure at a budget meeting.
This procedure must remain in effect for at least 3 budget years before the alternative
organizational structure may return to the requirement that a budget be approved at a
meeting of the voters of all of the member entities of the alternative organizational
structure.

31 An article to consider reinstatement of the budget approval procedure in which the 32 budget is approved at a meeting of the voters of all of the member entities may be 33 placed on a warrant for referendum vote by either a majority vote of the governing 34 body of the alternative organizational structure or by a written petition to the 35 governing body of the alternative organizational structure signed by a number of 36 voters of member entities of the alternative organizational structure equal to at least 37 10% of the voters who voted in the last gubernatorial election in the member entities of the alternative organizational structure. The governing body of the alternative 38 39 organizational structure shall place the article on the next scheduled warrant or an 40 earlier one if determined appropriate by the governing body of the alternative organizational structure. The article to be voted upon must be in substantially the 41 42 following form:

5	If approved by a majority of the total number of voters of all of the member entities
6	in the alternative organizational structure, the budget approval procedure changes to a
7	meeting of the voters of all of the member entities of the alternative organizational
8	structure beginning in the next budget year or the following budget year if the
9	approval occurs less than 90 days before the start of the next budget year. Once
10	approved by the voters, this procedure may not be changed for at least 3 budget years.
