COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1294, L.D. 1759

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2. Chair; meetings; secretary; quorum. The Pull Events Commission shall elect one of its members as chair. The chair serves a 2-year term and may not serve as chair for consecutive terms. The commission shall meet a minimum of twice annually. The commissioner shall designate a person to serve as secretary to the Pull Events Commission. <u>A quorum of the commission for the transaction of business is 6 members</u>. <u>An action may not be taken by the commission without approval of a majority of the members present</u>.

Sec. 3. 7 MRSA §98, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 2005, c. 563, §3, is amended to read:

3. Terms; vacancies. Appointments to the Pull Events Commission must be for terms of 2 <u>3</u> years. The appointing authority fills a vacancy for a full 2 year <u>3-year</u> term. The appointing authority may remove a commission member for cause, which includes poor attendance. The chair shall make recommendations to the appointing authority concerning a removal.

Sec. 4. Staggered terms. Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 7,
 section 98, subsections 1 and 3, the terms of members appointed to the Pull Events
 Commission in 2012 are as follows:

The term of one member appointed under Title 7, section 98, subsection 1,
 paragraph A is one year and the term of the other member is 3 years;

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2. The term of the members appointed under Title 7, section 98, subsection 1, paragraphs B, D, E and F is 2 years;

3. The term of the members appointed under Title 7, section 98, subsection 1,
paragraphs C and H is one year; and

4. The term of the members appointed under Title 7, section 98, subsection 1,
paragraphs C-1 and D-1 is 3 years.'

SUMMARY

This amendment increases the membership of the Pull Events Commission from 9 to 27 28 10 and revises the membership by specifying that 2 members are appointed by farmers 29 associations representing owners of animals who participate in pull events. It specifies 30 that the fair superintendent who serves on the commission is appointed by the 31 Commissioner of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources. It provides for a member to be 32 appointed by a state association of agricultural fairs. It eliminates the member representing the animal pulling industry appointed by the Commissioner of Agriculture, 33 34 Food and Rural Resources.

It provides for the staggering of the terms of members appointed in 2012. Subsequent appointments are for 3 years. It requires 6 members of the 10-member commission to be present to transact business and that a majority vote of those present is necessary to approve any action.
