14 SUMMARY
This amendment is the minority report of the committee. The bill allows
16 commercial business to be issued a permit for open burning of leaves, brush, deadwoo
and tree cuttings that are accrued from normal property maintenance, removed from
residential property and burned at the business's primary business location. Th
amendment removes the provision in the bill that allows a permit for open burning at th
business location to be issued only 4 times per calendar year.
