SENATE AMENDMENT "**A**" to H.P. 1304, L.D. 1772, Bill, "An Act To Enforce Prompt Payment to Career and Technical Education Regions"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §8463-A in subsection 3 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 14 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "60th" and inserting the following: '120th'

Amend the bill in section 1 in §8463-A in subsection 4 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 17 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "60" and inserting the following: '120'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment increases from 60 days to 120 days the amount of time that must elapse after the date an installment is due before a career and technical education region may sue to compel payment.
