COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1306, L.D. 1775, "Resolve, Regarding Legislative Review of Portions of Chapter 115: Certification, Authorization and Approval of Education Personnel, Parts I and II, a Major Substantive Rule of the Department of Education and the State Board of Education"

Amend the resolve in section 1 in the last line (page 1, line 18 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "authorized" the following: 'only if that portion of the rule designated as Part II, Section 2.7, subsection B, paragraph 4, Certificate Eligibility Pathway 4, is amended to clarify the 4 distinct requirements of this eligibility pathway.'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment conditionally authorizes a major substantive rule of the Department of Education and the State Board of Education, Chapter 115: Certification, Authorization and Approval of Education Personnel, Parts I and II. The Department of Education and the State Board of Education are directed to amend the rule to clarify that in order to meet Certificate Eligibility Pathway 4, all 4 requirements need to be met.
