18	This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, removes
19	municipalities from the stakeholder group reviewing prequalification processes for
20	contractors. In the amendment, the stakeholder group does not include a representative of
21	municipalities, and municipal projects that require prequalification are not included as
22 23	part of the review of when the state prequalification process can be used. The
23 24	amendment adds to the stakeholder group representatives from a statewide organization representing organized labor and a statewide organization representing building trades
25	within the State.
