
SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1371, L.D. 1853, Bill, "An Act To Improve Environmental Oversight and Streamline Permitting for Mining in Maine"

Amend the amendment in section 23 in §490-OO by adding after subsection 6 the following:

'7. County approval. A mining permit may not be issued under this section unless the proposed mining operation has been approved by a referendum of the voters of the county or counties in which the proposed mining operation is located.'

SUMMARY

This amendment provides that a mining permit may not be issued unless the proposed mining operation has been approved by a referendum of the voters of the county or counties in which the proposed mining operation is located.
