HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1383,
L.D. 1868, Bill, "An Act To Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Laws of Maine"

Amend the amendment by inserting after Part E the following:

'PART F

Sec. F-1. 10 MRSA §9903, sub-§1, ¶B, as enacted by PL 2011, c. 622, §1, is amended to read:

B. Unemployment insurance, taxes or fees or workers' compensation insurance taxes or fees; and

Sec. F-2. Retroactivity. That section of this Part that amends the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 10, section 9903, subsection 1, paragraph B applies retroactively to April 12, 2012.'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment corrects a clerical error by removing a comma that was erroneously included in a description of the fees and taxes that are not required to be paid by an out-of-state business that responds to a state of emergency in this State. The law corrected by this amendment was enacted by Public Law 2011, chapter 622.
