Amend the amendment in division (k) in the first line (page 2, line 1 in amendment) by striking out the following: "The" and inserting the following: 'Beginning January 1, 2015, the'

Amend the amendment on page 2 in division (e) in the first line (page 2, line 10 in amendment) by striking out the following: "The" and inserting the following: 'Beginning January 1, 2015, the'

Amend the amendment in subparagraph (5) in the first line (page 2, line 20 in amendment) by striking out the following: "A" and inserting the following: 'Beginning January 1, 2015, a'

Amend the amendment on page 2 by striking out the 5th indented paragraph (page 2, line 27 in amendment)

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 2.

This amendment delays until January 1, 2015 when certain information must be included in the report on the performance of the Child Development Services System



Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment eliminates the one-time General Fund appropriations of \$70,050 in fiscal year 2013-14 and \$92,400 in fiscal year 2014-15 to the Child Development Services System (CDS) by delaying when certain information on the performance of the CDS System must be reported until January 1, 2015. CDS expects to have a new data system in place at that time that will allow the information to be collected and reported electronically.
