| 2 | This amendment is the majority report of the Joint Standing Committee on Judiciary. |
| 3 | This amendment provides for the appointment, rather than the election, of the initial |
| 4 | Representative to the Legislature of the Aroostook Band of Micmacs to the 127th |
| 5 | Legislature. It also provides that the changes do not take effect unless the Aroostook |
| 6 | Band of Micmacs approves them and provides certification of that approval to the |
| 7 | Secretary of State within 90 days of the adjournment of the First Regular Session of the |
| 8 | 126th Legislature. |
| 9 | The amendment also adds an appropriations and allocations section. |
