2 **Sec. 1. 19-A MRSA §1659, sub-§9,** as enacted by PL 2009, c. 345, §2, is
3 repealed.

4 **SUMMARY**

5 Current law allowing a court to appoint a 3rd party as a parent coordinator to oversee
6 and resolve disputes that arise between parents in interpreting and implementing a
7 parenting plan set by the court contains a self-repealing provision by which the law is
8 repealed on January 1, 2014. This bill eliminates that repeal.
